

## **Report of Stampex 2011 National Competition Jury:**

To say the least, this exhibition has broken a number of records. To have awarded seven Large Gold and twelve Gold medals gives an indication of the high standard shown by the exhibits. However, 22 exhibits are first time entries into the UK National Exhibitions and even more pleasing, a number of exhibitors have taken note of advice given at previous exhibitions and have improved their exhibits. For any judge, this latter achievement is the biggest accolade that any exhibitor can give a judge.

Three teams of three judges undertook the judging over two days. As Chairman of the Jury I would like to thank them all for giving up so much time to this exhibition – the judges were Christine Earle (Secretary to the Jury), Birthe King, Colin Hoffman, Chris King, Brian Moorhouse, Robin Pizer, Brian Trotter, with James Podger as apprentice.

One comment we would like to make is about the mounting up of exhibits. Within the frames pages are vertical and without some rigidity, they tend to flop within, or even fall out of, the frames. Even the addition of thin card (available cheaply from any stationer) within the protector avoids this problem. Similarly, mounting paper, whether an envelope or piece of paper, on the album page using hinges or small corner mounts may cause damage to the philatelic item. Large commercially available corner mounts are strongly recommended – many items shown are of high value, either monetary or historical, and should be treated accordingly.

We would like to thank the British Philatelic Trust for sponsoring the exhibition and providing the facilities that enabled the judging to be undertaken efficiently.
