INTRODUCTION

This Exhibition is organized by Stamp World Exhibitions (SWE), a company limited by guarantee, on behalf of the Association of British Philatelic Societies (ABPS).

This is a non-competitive National Exhibition, open to all exhibitors. No facilities are available for National Commissioners. This document provides information for those wishing to enter an exhibit.

Exhibits may ONLY be entered non-competitively and any philatelic items may be shown as there is no judging.

Exhibits are only accepted in the form of scans produced at 300dpi in any usually found file format. Oversized pages can be used up to A3 or similar. Other oversized pages may be accepted, subject to confirmation by the organizers whose contact details are shown below.

There is a charge of £20 for each 16-page (or equivalent) frame.

A. TIMETABLE

Deadline for receipt of applications and delivery of electronic exhibits 1 March 2021 (the dates are intentionally the same)

Removal of virtual exhibits from the ABPS website 20 April 2021

B. FRAME ALLOCATION

You may enter any number of frames.

C. GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Eligibility

All are welcome to exhibit.

2. Organizer's Discretion

As the organizer, SWE reserves the right to determine whether an entry should be accepted or displayed in this exhibition, without having to give a reason for any decisions.

3. Language

It is recommended that exhibits are written in English, b. But exhibits are accepted in others <u>FIP</u> languages. We suggest that if English is not used, the front page is provided with English details of the exhibit.

4. Application Procedure

Applications should be made using the online application form which is available at www.abps.org.uk under the Exhibiting tab.

PLEASE USE ANY APPROPRIATE CLASS ON THE APPLICATION FORM DROP-DOWN LIST.

All exhibits will be displayed on the ABPS website until 30 April 2021. Any exhibitor <u>not</u> wishing to exhibit until 30 April 2021, MUST request this by email to the organizers at the email address above.

5. Acceptance

Acceptance of applications is at the discretion of the organizers.

All entrants whose applications are accepted will receive notification with instructions and specific dates/times.

6. Entry Fees

The entry fees are £20 per frame. Payments must be made in sterling and are non-refundable. Payments can be made:

7. Exhibits: Introductory Page

An introductory page is not required with the application, but it is recommended that one is provided in the exhibit. A **synopsis** is not accepted.
