This is a National Exhibition, open to all exhibitors resident in the United Kingdom and to exhibitors from other countries in accordance with Section C7 of the General Rules. No facilities are available for National Commissioners.

The usual National Competition will be held, and the British Thematic Association (BTA) will be the lead organization for thematic displays. Information regarding taking part in thematic element of the exhibition may be found on the BTA website - <u>Autumn Stampex 2021 - Events - British Thematic Association</u>. Entries outside the lead society are most welcome. Please select on the entry from whether your exhibit is competitive or noncompetitive.

All arrangements for the insurance, delivery and return of exhibits are the sole responsibility and at the cost of the exhibitor. When necessary, this includes making arrangements for customs clearance and any attendant customs duties and costs.

Frame Fees

£25 per frame, whether single or multiple frame exhibits, and £25 per literature entry. All entries will receive a Certificate of Entry and letter of thanks. Only multi-frame competitive entries in physical competitions (as opposed to virtual competitions) will receive a medal.

Please note that the FIP have stated that virtual exhibits obtaining qualifying points in 2021/22 will be eligible to enter its international exhibitions in 2021/22. If you wish to enter an FIP exhibition outside these dates with an exhibit qualified at a virtual exhibition, we suggest you check the FIP website first and, if necessary, contact the commissioner allocated to the exhibition by your National association—the ABPS in the case of the UK.
