Although the number of societies affiliated to ABPS has been maintained, local club society membership is down 8.6% since last year although specialist society membership is down less at 4.4% and national societies membership have increased by 2.6%. This remains a concern, so we all need to play our part in promoting philately across the UK.

Following the resignation of Willie King, Neil Ritchie has taken over as Secretary of ABPS and George Henshilwood has joined the Committee as the representative for Scotland.

FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

The accounts for 2015 can now be found on the ABPS website.

Income has fallen again reflecting the overall fall in society membership across the country. The association has been more active in providing grants and maintaining its profile via the website. Publication costs have fallen, simply reflecting that five printing bills for ABPS News were made in 2014 as against four in 2015. The overall deficit is comparable with the previous year. The increase in the level of capitation fees is unlikely to improve the position for 2015 as the publication of the ABPS Handbook will utilise these additional funds.
