AGM NEWS

The Association's AGM was held at York on 20th July.

George Henshilwood has now been appointed as Secretary with Neil Ritchie moving to a key role in assisting the development of the ABPS website.

Steve Harrison was appointed Vice-Chairman.

The list of Federation Judges is being updated but this is proving more difficult than expected as only half of the Secretaries of the Federations have responded to enquiries from Alan Godfrey.

The capitation fee will be £1.50 per member from 1st January 2020.

Ten new banners are being prepared for the promotion of ABPS at regional and national events, sponsored by Cavendish Philatelic Auctions.

Presentations were made at the AGM to winners of the Award of Merit and the Congress Medal was presented to Gerald Marriner.

AUTUMN STAMPEX

This takes place at the Business Design Centre, London from 11th to 14th September.

The Court of Honour will feature the award-winning collection of "Concorde" by Brian Asquith. The lead Society will be the National Philatelic Society.

A new initiative will see tours of the Exhibition available including explanations of the competitive entries. There is also a seminar of how to exhibit and display your collection.

Please note there will be no Spring Stampex in 2020 because of the proximity to the London 2020 International Exhibition in May.
